Logic Models provide a clear roadmap to a specified end. A program logic model details resource, planned activities, and their outputs and outcomes over time that reflects intended results. Logic models offer a way to describe and share an understanding of relationships among elements necessary to operate a program or change effort. Knowlton & Phillips (2008)
